OH&S COMPLIANCE:

AEP instructions (**Doc5**) presented by Marilou Montemayor.

Proposed amendments to existing SEAWA policy documents (**Doc6**) for compliance; references (**Docs7, 8, 9**) presented by Marilou Montemayor.

SEAWA'S INPUT TO THE CITY OF MEDICINE HAT MUNICIPAL

DEVELOPMENT PLAN:

A draft input outline/ structure guided by the SSRP & Water for Life (**Doc11**) presented by Marilou Montemayor.

MDP and Sustainability Plan. Previous plan lacked some environment components. Environmental contributions should reflect those of the SSRP, including a 30% decrease in water consumption (recommendation under Conservation, Efficiency, and Productivity, Alberta Water Council). The city should adopt an environmental management master plan with components of climate adaptation.

Plan should include conservation offset guidelines and performance measures of implementation and effectiveness.
